Introduction

The 'Toolkit' is the action component of the report! Below are brief introduction paragraphs. These are followed by some suggestions of Organizations working with Electric School Bus (ESB) Adoption and Advocacy to further your research. Then a Reports, Further Learning and Research section highlighting other aspects of electric school buses, such as range, routes, costs, debunking myths, etc. There is also a Resources for kid's section.

Tools – Contacts will be where you can find lists of the relevant people to contact about getting an electric school bus in your region (e.g. schools!). Following this section is the Tools-Materials to wrap up the toolkit, which is comprised of materials including videos, factsheets, email templates, call scripts, etc. Notably, these can be hard conversations and topics to explore – we encourage you to check out the resources for eco-anxiety and check in with yourself on your advocacy endeavors.

I am a...

PARENT

As a concerned parent, we encourage you to explore the electric school bus movement further. Involve your child in your conversations and learning. Engage in conversations with your local MPs, provincial premier, and school principal. Encourage teachers to discuss this topic in the classroom, and share your thoughts with neighbours, friends, fellow parents, and family.

TEACHER

As a concerned teacher, we encourage you to explore the electric school bus movement further. Bring the topics into your classroom, using any of the materials linked below, or reach out to some of the organizations below to inquire about class materials or guest presentations.

Send home handouts with your students. Use your voice to speak out with principals, other teachers, and staff members within the school district. Contact your local MPs, provincial premiers, and other members of the government. Depending on the location, bring these conversations to your union.

SCHOOL STAFF / BOARD MEMBER / PRINCIPAL

As a concerned staff, principal or board member with a school we encourage you to further your research. Once familiar with this issue, use your voice to push your school to consider electric. Reach out to the organizations below and ask for school presentations, or materials.

Bring the conversation to the province, and advocate for these changes. Review the curriculum for information about electric school buses, suggest teachers address these topics in the classroom, and share knowledge with parents at the schools.

HEALTH PROFESSIONAL

As a concerned health professional, we encourage you to further your knowledge. Once familiar with the subject, we encourage you to speak out. With other healthcare professionals, use your voice to express concerns with government officials at municipal and provincial levels. Advocate for change with school principals, board members, and staff.

YOUTH

As a concerned kid, we encourage you to let your parents know you want to learn more about electric school buses, climate change, and the environment.

AGES 5-13

We recommend your family read about organizations working on electric vehicles. And you can also read or watch resources for kids! Bring up electric buses with your teachers and principals. You can also sit down with your family and write letters or emails to different members of the government.

AGES 13+

We recommend looking more into the different organizations advocating for electric vehicles, reading and watching resources for kids about electric buses. Speak with your teachers and principals about starting your school's own advocacy group. Talk to your family about how you can get in touch with members of the education centre, City Hall, or provincial government.

SCHOOL BUS DRIVER

As a concerned bus driver, we recommend researching organizations working for more electric vehicles, and diving more into the subject to answer any questions you may have. Reach out to your coworkers, supervisors, and union representatives to begin conversations around advocating for electric school buses for your health, safety, and well-being. You may also want to talk to members of the government such as your councillor, MLA, or MP

GOVERNMENT WORKER

As a concerned government worker, we suggest connecting with supportive organizations, reading reports, watching videos, and attending presentations and webinars. These resources can help you determine how best to advocate for more electric school buses in your region.
