

Petition to the Nova Scotia Provincial Government Stop the Tonal Noise from the Donkin Coal Mine

To: The Honourable Minister of Environment & Climate Change

For years, residents living near the Donkin Mine have endured relentless noise pollution. The tonal noise emitted from the mine's operations has resulted in chronic sleep deprivation, increased stress levels, and a significant deterioration in both physical and mental health among residents. No community should be expected to live under such conditions.
